In the spring, Omega Tau Omega Chapter will award <u>six</u> college scholarships to high school students, based on requirements, eligibility, and criteria. The awarding of the scholarships actuates our mission to be of service to all mankind by supporting lifelong learning.

## Requirements & Eligibility:

- Applicants <u>must</u> be an African American male or female high school senior graduating in May or June 2024.
- Applicants <u>must</u> be planning to attend an accredited college, university, or other higher learning institution. Scholarship recipients must provide proof of acceptance and enrollment before funds are disbursed.
- Applicants **must** have a minimum **2.5 grade point average** on a 4-point scale (unweighted).
- Applicants **must** reside in South Carolina or North Carolina.

The application packet **<u>must</u>** include the following:

- A completed 2024 application form which includes evidence of a **minimum** of 20 community service hours over the past year.
- The applicant's *official* high school transcript.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (letters from family will not be accepted).
- A typed essay on the topic as indicated on the application form.
- A wallet size photograph.
- Selection of *one* scholarship category (see signature page).

### The application process begins December 1st and ends on April 30th.

All application packets must be postmarked on or before April 30, 2024. Incomplete or late application packets will not be considered.
